

DEIP CEO Forum

15 November 2019

Background:

- The Distributed Energy Integration Program (**DEIP**) is a collaboration of 13 organisations working to maximise the value of customers' distributed resources for all energy users.
- In November 2019, the CEOs and senior representatives of DEIP met to reflect on the first year of delivery and agree on the next priorities.

Discussion included:

- Revisit DEIP's purpose in the context of the DER transition
- DEIP's achievements to date
- How to improve the DEIP's effectiveness
- A review and endorsement of DEIP's work plan for 2020
- DEIP's governance and resourcing arrangements

Outcomes:

- The DEIP CEO Forum supported the continuation of DEIP, which was recognised as a valuable industry collaboration
- Endorsement of the proposed work plan and KPIs for 2020
- Commitment of ongoing in-kind support to continue the collaboration and implement the proposed work packages

2020 work packages

1. **DER Access, Pricing:** Evolving regulatory frameworks to meet changing community expectations and higher penetration of DER
2. **DER Interoperability:** Coordinating DER interoperability platform, cyber security & device standards
3. **DER Market Development:** Trialing DER marketplaces to deliver the most best outcome for consumers
4. **Electric Vehicles:** Facilitating the efficient integration of EVs into existing networks and markets
